- 3. 2023/2024 Precept – Following a comprehensive discussion, it was proposed by Heddwyn Jones and seconded by Caroline Williams that we increase the Precept by 15% for the year 2023 – 2024.

2937 Poverty Fund – The Clerk reported that an application had been made to the County Council for financial support to the value of £5000 in order to provide meals for elderly and disadvantaged residents in the Parish. If the application is successful the Community Council will provide match funding of £5000 for the initiative.
